Some important information re: membership options

If you think you are likely to begin riding at club social rides or any Mountain Biking Australia (MTBA) sanctioned events such as the Paluma Push, Herberton 8 Hour, Rockwheelers inaugural Ross Dam 8 Hour (part of the NQ Suncorp Games in April 2008), Triple R and more, then consider taking up a full rider membership which is \$30 per year.

Rockwheelers rider members are required to also have MTBA membership — Recreational or Competition (Senior or Junior). To help you decide which type suits you best we have outlined some of the differences in the table below.

If you decide to become a rider member then visit the website to download both Rockwheelers and MTBA membership forms which are found under “Membership & Club Info”.

What does your MTBA membership cover your for?

Cost	\$15 per event / ride (social rides and recreational or competition event)	\$42 per year, can be up-graded to Competition at any time but no pro-rata allowance	\$80 Senior, \$60 Junior (U19) per year or \$36 with Cycling Australia Value-Add membership
Limitations	One event / ride only	Recreational class and social rides only. Lasts 12 months. If entering a <u>competition class</u> at an event a Day License must be purchased. PLEASE NOTE: Day License insurance cover takes precedence over your Recreational insurance cover during a competition event. See this table.	All MTBA sanctioned events are covered including competition and social rides. Lasts 12 months.
